Written Submission Instructions

Submission

Once your school is registered, we will accept submissions from 1st November 2017 to 15th January 2018. To submit your student's work, please follow this Step-by-Step Guide:

Please do not insert pictures, backgrounds, borders, etc. They will not attribute to extra marks as we are only interested in the student's writing.

The HKYWA team will manage the publishing process and ensure the entries look attractive and consistent in the final publications.

How to Submit

- In word document format by attaching them to one e-mail addressed to: hkywa2018@ppp.com.hk with a max of 10 entries per teacher
- The entries must only feature the title and written text of the students' work - no student/teacher names or school name is required.
- Each word document attached must have a very specific filename.
School Name, Student's name, Category & Group.doc
e.g. Carmel Pak U Secondary School, Gabrielle Tse Mei Ying, Fiction Group 4.doc

(Excel document attached) These details include: School Name, Student First & Last Name, Student Age, Submission Title, Category and Group, Teacher Name and Filename eg Hong Kong School, Daniel Tan, Fiction Group 3.doc
