

Instructions for Hard Copy Submission for Chinese Calligraphy



- All submissions must be based on the topic – *New Tales of China's Silk Road*
- Each student can only submit one entry.
- Each registered teacher can submit **10 entries in each group**.
- In no more than 28 Chinese words, describe the Silk Road you have in mind.
- This is the Chinese calligraphy category, judges will look at the content, as well as the aesthetic of the work.
- Any of the 5 calligraphy styles will be acceptable 楷書、行書、草書、隸書、篆書
- Submissions have to be written with traditional Chinese calligraphy brush (Máobǐ) and ink and not modern calligraphy pens.
- Each submission must include a Cover Sheet (attached).
- Chinese calligraphy paper size **not bigger than A3, portrait orientation**.
- Chinese calligraphy must carry the Author's Name on the back.
- Please remember to fill in and submit the Chinese calligraphy Submission Form, each school must submit **ONE** entry form (attached) containing details of all the students submitting.
- We must receive the hard copy submissions by 15th January 2026.
- All Chinese Calligraphy Submissions must be postmarked on or before 14th January 2026.
